In numele Autoritatii de Management pentru Programul Operational Comun Bazinul Marii Negre 2014-2020, avem placerea de a va invita la sesiunile de informare care vor fi organizate la Burgas/Bulgaria in data de 8 noiembrie 2016, la Constanta/Romania in data de 10 noiembrie 2016 si la Salonic/Grecia in data de 8 decembrie 2016.

1. Autoritati locale, regionale si, daca este necesar pentru obiectivul proiectului, autoritati nationale;
2. Organisme de utilitate publica precum institute detinute la nivel national/regional, universitati si institutii de invatamant, agentii de turism si agentii de dezvoltare regionale, institutii/asociatii culturale si arheologice, organisme de management ale parcurilor naturale si ariilor naturale protejate si institute de cercetare;
3. Organizatii non-profit, precum asociatii, uniuni, fundatii, universitati private in cazul in care statutul lor legal este de organizatie non-profit, Gruparea Europeana de Cooperare Teritoriala).

Important! Organizatiile participante trebuie sa se inregistreze doar la evenimentul din tara in care sunt inregistrate si in care isi au resedinta.

- To raise awareness of the Black Sea Basin programme, the opportunities for cross-border cooperation it offers, and the benefits it can bring to the region
- To introduce key elements of the draft version of the BSB application pack and of the relevant national legislation
- To provide information, training, and tips on the main steps in preparing ENI CBC project proposals and how to complete an application under the first call for proposals using the electronic Monitoring System (eMS)

Target Groups

Eligible Bulgarian/Greek/Romanian potential applicants registered and located in one of the Programme eligible regions (**Bulgaria** – NUTS II regions of Severoiztochen and Yugoiztochen, **Greece** – NUTS II regions of Kentriki Makedonia and Anatoliki Makedonia – Thraki and **Romania** – NUTS II region of South-East), falling under one of the categories below:

1. Local, regional and, if needed for the project purpose, national authorities;
2. Bodies governed by public law, such as state/regional owned institutes, universities and educational institutions, tourism and regional development agencies, cultural and archaeological associations/institutions, nature park and protected areas management bodies, and research institutes;
3. Non-profit organisations such as associations, unions, foundations, private universities if their legal status is of a non-profit organization, Euro regions, European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation.
