Financed by the South-East Europe Transnational Cooperation Programme, TRANSDANUBE project – “Sustainable Transport and Tourism along the Danube” aims to develop transnational partnerships in strategic fields for the improvement of territorial, economical and social integration process contributing to cohesion, stability and competitiveness.

This aspect is proved by the participation in this project of 14 partners from Austria, Bulgaria, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Romania, Croatia and Serbia and 35 Associated Strategic Partners (ASP) and Observers.
