**Priorities and measures for the development of
the “Danube Delta” Biosphere Reserve and
“Macin Mountains” National Park
protected areas**

The South-East Regional Development Agency (SE RDA) organises, within the TRANSDANUBE project – “Sustainable Transport and Tourism along the Danube”, the workshop aiming to identify and prioritise strategic objectives and measures necessary to include them in the Action Plan for Sustainable Development of Transport and Tourism as well as to facilitate the access to the “Danube Delta” Biosphere Reserve and “Macin Mountains” National Park protected areas.

The event will take place at Tulcea County Council, „Dobrogea” Room, on 28th June 2013, starting with 11 a.m.

As concerns the “Danube Delta” Biosphere Reserve and “Macin Mountains” National Park, the project aims to achieve the following activities:

- Development of a State of Art analysis on mobility and tourism;
- Development of an integrated ecotourism system for the capitalization of cultural and natural resources in the Danube Delta combining the bike trails from localities along the Danube with bus and ship transport offers;
- Development of an Action Plan for Sustainable Development of Transport and Tourism as well as facilitation of access to protected areas;
- Creation of a digital map with information regarding tourism and transport offers;
- Development of a marketing plan for tourism promotion and sustainable transport in the Danube Region.
